

Comprehensive Planning Underway for Alamo Heights

Comprehensive Plan Neighborhood Meetings to gather input for the future of Alamo Heights have begun. The meetings are part of a concerted effort by City Council and City staff to elicit feedback from citizens regarding their vision of what Alamo Heights should be 15 years from now. "Our job at this point is to listen to the hopes and dreams of our citizens." said Ann McGlone, Director of Community Development.

Comprehensive planning allows a community to manage changes in a way that is responsive to the needs and perceptions of its residents, business owners, employees, visitors and other stakeholders. Through a planning process that combines public involvement, data analysis and creative thinking, Alamo Heights will be able to plan for a future that maintains neighborhood character and quality of life while guiding positive change.

Neighborhood meetings continue through November 20. The ideas from these meetings will shape the vision used to develop the comprehensive plan. Future opportunities to participate in this process will be through the Winter 2008 Community Design Workshop, the Spring 2009 Neighborhood Sessions and the Spring 2009 Community Gathering.
