The general election will be held on May 9, 2015 to elect Mayor and Councilmember Place One to serve a term of two years for their respective places. *Councilmember Place Two is unopposed.*

**Election Day: Saturday, May 9th**

**Where: Alamo Heights Council Chambers - 6116 Broadway**

**Precincts: 3020, 3025 and 3026**

**When: 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.**

**Early Voting:** Alamo Heights voters will be able to vote at any polling site throughout Bexar County, beginning **Monday, April 27th through Tuesday, May 5th**. The closest early voting polling sites to Alamo Heights are: **Lion's Field Community Center located at 2809 Broadway, Olmos Park City Hall located at 120 W. El Prado, and Tobin Library located at 4134 Harry Wurzbach**

### Yardwork Regulations

With Spring approaching many residents are beginning to work on landscaping projects and hiring contractors to complete yard work.

- Reminder contractors who are providing landscape and/or tree trimming services are required to remove all tree/shrub limb cuttings, grass clippings and leaves after they complete the work.
- All grass clippings or leaves are to be bagged and hauled off by the contractor and not blown onto public streets or bagged and left for the City to dispose of.
- Contractors are not to begin working before 10:00 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and City-observed holidays.
- If you have any questions on the City Codes that regulate yard work contact Public Works at 882-1518.

### Mosquito Control

With all the moisture in the air mosquitoes have found ideal breeding grounds. By following some tips residents can assist with the effort to reduce the mosquito numbers and helps protect yourself from being bitten.

- DRAIN – Eliminate any potential standing water on your property.
- DEFEND – Use an EPA-registered mosquito repellent such as DEET, Picardidin or oil of lemon eucalyptus.
- DRESS – Wear light colored, loose fitting clothing that minimizes skin exposure.


