Items for Individual Consideration

Item # 1 Mayor Cooper read the following caption.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2064**

**AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

City Secretary Jennifer Reyna presented the official results of the special election that was held on November 8, 2016. Ms. Reyna reported the Early Voting and Election Day Totals for the proposition. There were a total of 3,963 voters who cast their ballots. The City of Alamo Heights has a total of 5,759 registered voters in which the City had 68% voter turnout for the special election and the proposition passed. The reauthorization is valid for four years terminating on March 31, 2021.

Proposition

The reauthorization of a local sales and use tax in the City of Alamo Heights at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.
