This letter is being written for the City Zoning variance application on behalf of Rick and Suzanne Cavender, residents of 524 Alta Ave, Alamo Heights, TX 78209. The purpose of this appeal is in regards to the location their standby home generator installation.

The applicants are proposing to place their home standby generator in a location considered to be the front yard of their property under Section 3-81 of the City's Zoning Code. This appeal is relevant as the proposed placement of the generator will locate it between the front setback of the property and the front fascia of the home.

Herein, the applicants appeal the proposed location of their standby generator on the grounds that the proposed location is adequately concealed from the front property line and that the proposed location is at a lower elevation than will be easily noticed from the front of the property.
