Item # 1 Mayor Rosenthal read the following caption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2100

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 421 PROHIBITING ANY PERSON OTHER THAN AN AUTHORIZED PEACE OFFICER FROM CARRYING A LOADED RIFLE OR SHOTGUN IN THE CITY

Police Chief Rick Pruitt made a PowerPoint presentation that included background information.

Ordinance No. 421 was passed on October 12, 1964 prohibiting a person other than a peace officer from possessing or transporting a loaded rifle or shotgun in a public place or in a motor vehicle. He stated State and Federal Court ruling have since been recorded regarding a state's ability to regulate firearms which conflicted with Ordinance No. 421. Texas legislature allows the concealed and open carry of handguns by persons qualified to obtain a license to carry.

Texas Legislature had not passed a regulation or law prohibiting a person from carrying a rifle or shotgun in a place not otherwise prohibited by law or restricting a person from carrying or possessing a loaded rifle or shotgun providing the firearm is not accessible to children.

Police Chief Pruitt stated the Police Department will explore all cases and monitor; however, any police action taken would only be in response to illegal conduct of involved persons and not the mere presence of firearms otherwise being carried openly and in a place not restricted by law.

A motion for approval was made by Councilmember Lynda Billa Burke. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Fred Prassel and passed by unanimous vote.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Councilmember Prassel to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Billa Burke and passed by unanimous vote. Mayor Rosenthal adjourned the meeting at 8:49 a.m.
