## **ORDINANCE NO. 2077**

## AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 6, 2017

City Secretary Jennifer Reyna presented the official results of the special election that was held on May 6, 2017. Ms. Reyna reported the Early Voting and Election Day Totals for the proposition. There were a total of 1,110 voters who cast their ballots. The City of Alamo Heights has a total of 5,587 registered voters in which the City had 20% voter turnout for the special election and the proposition passed. The authorization is valid for four years terminating on September 30, 2021.

## **Proposition**

The adoption of a new local sales and use tax in the City of Alamo Heights at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide additional revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets and sidewalks.
