CROSS STREET CAREFULLY

WALK SAFELY

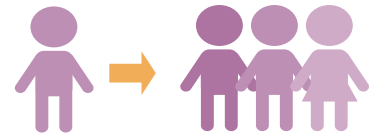
- Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks
- Always walk on sidewalks or paths
- If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible



DO NOT EAT CANDY UNTIL GET HOME

CHECK CANDY

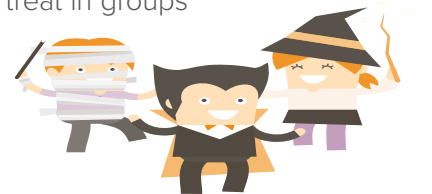
- Do not eat candy until checked for signs of tampering
- Homemade treats should not be eaten unless absolutely sure they are safe
- Eat treats only in original wrappers



STAY AS GROUP

TRICK OR TREAT WITH AN ADULT AND/OR IN GROUPS

- Children under the age of 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision
- Older kids should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups



TIPS FOR TRICK-OR-TREATERS

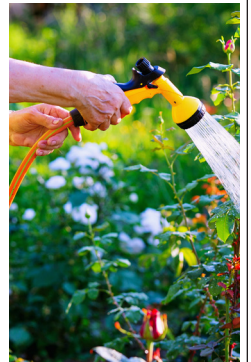
- Make sure costumes fit and are light or bright colored
- Wear comfortable shoes
- Approach only houses with their lights on
- Carry a flashlight and cell phone

Winter Averaging

A reminder that your water consumption during the winter months affects your residential sewer service fee for next year. Residential sewer service fees are calculated based on the average water usage during three consecutive billing periods.

This year your November, December, and January consumption will be used for your winter averaging.
