Local Sales and Use Tax for Street Maintenance

On May 6, 2017, the City of Alamo Heights conducted a special election to consider the adoption of a new local sales and use tax in the City of Alamo Heights at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. This will be effective October 1, 2017 and valid for four years. Unofficial results are 923 in favor and 187 in opposition. The proposition passed and results will be canvassed on Wednesday, May 17, 2017 at 8:30 a.m.

Oaths will be administered to Mayor-Elect Bobby Rosenthal, Councilmember Lawson Jessee, Place 1 and Councilmember Wes Sharples, Place 2 at the Monday, May 22, 2017 Council meeting beginning at 5:30 p.m. Congratulations!
