Yard Piping Project for Sylvan Hills & Bluebonnet Neighborhoods

Recently, the City of Alamo Heights installed new water meter boxes in the front of each residence throughout the Sylvan Hills and Bluebonnet neighborhoods. Starting this August, yard piping will be necessary to create a new underground water service line connecting the new front-yard water meter box to the home's existing water line which is currently behind your house. This work follows the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's (TCEQ) mandates and allows the City to improve accessibility, emergency response, and long-term service.

When to Expect Your Service:

Alamo Heights and Abelar Inc. will begin yard piping this August and expect the entire project to be completed within 4-6 months, with approximately 5 residences serviced each business day.

Water Restrictions

As of July 31, 2026, the City of Alamo Heights has declared Stage 1 Water Restrictions, as mandated by order of the Edwards Aquifer Authority.

Watering (using automatic or manual irrigation systems) is permitted **only once a week** between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. The last number of your address determines what day you are able to water.

A hand-held hose may be used during any day of the week at any time.

School Zone Safety

School begins on August 19th. AH Police Department urges all motorists to use caution and be more alert while driving on streets around the school campuses and anywhere children may be walking or riding their bicycles to school. Students are easily distracted this time of year and may inadvertently get too far away from the curb or cross the street without looking both ways.

Remember the speed limit in ALL school zones is 20 m.p.h.

Streets around school campuses can become heavily congested before and after school. If traveling through or near a school zone, please plan accordingly and expect delays.



1. OBEY TEXAS SCHOOL BUS LAW

- Stop for flashing red lights on a school bus, regardless of which direction you're headed
- Continue your trip once the flashing lights stop flashing
- Violations can lead to a \$1,000 fine

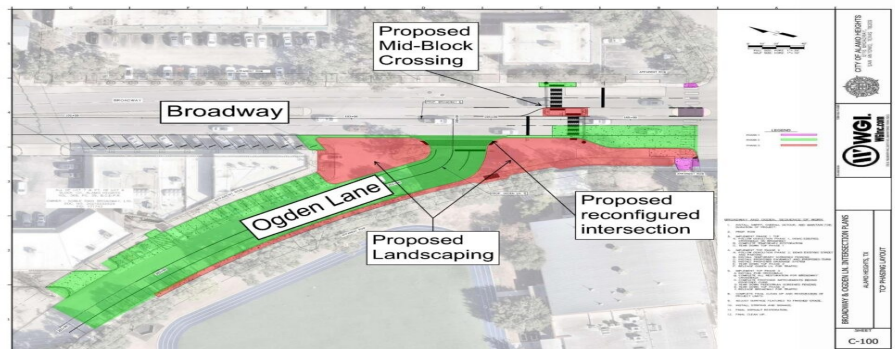
2. NO CELL PHONE IN SCHOOL ZONES

- No cell phone use in school zones
- No cell phone use by teens while driving who received license after September 1, 2009
- Beware of the posted signs designating the NO cell phone zones

Broadway and Ogden Lane Improvements

The City is near completion for the pedestrian-focused resign of Broadway and Ogden intersection. This includes a realigned intersection, new pedestrian mid-block crossing, widened sidewalks, patio/plaza space, and landscaped stormwater elements—an initiative born from City Council beautification workshops held in 2023-2024.

E-Z Bel Construction is targeted with a substantial completion in August, contingent on closing at Broadway to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during the work.
