Alamo Heights achieves ISO Class 1 Rate

The Alamo Heights Fire Department was recognized at the July 23, 2023 City Council meeting for being certified as an ISO Class 1 Community, the highest level of protection, effective June 1, 2023.

The ISO (Insurance Services Office) Fire Score is a rating that determines how well the fire department can protect your community and home. Insurance companies use the score to help set home insurance rates.

There are only 474 Class 1 fire agencies in the United States and only 90 in Texas, establishing the Alamo Heights Fire Department as an elite fire protection agency!

Be sure to check with your homeowners/property insurance for the proper rating.

Friendly reminder that the City is currently under Stage 4 Water Restrictions, effective July 24th.

- Landscape watering is permitted once EVERY OTHER week from 7am-11am and 7pm-11pm. The last number of your address determines what day.
- Hand watering with a hand-held hose, soaker hose, drip irrigation system, or bucket is allowed any day from 7am-11am and 7pm-11pm.
