What is the Census? The 2020 Census counts every person living in the 50 states, District of Columbia, and five U.S. territories.

Census 2020 is mandated by the Constitution and conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, a nonpartisan government agency.

The census provides critical data that law-makers, business owners, teachers, and many others use to provide daily services, products, and support for you and your community.

Every year, billions of dollars in federal funding go to hospitals, fire departments, schools, roads, and other resources based on census data.

It is Census 2020 Awareness period as the official count begins April 1, 2020.

SEWER AVERAGE

Winter Averaging monitors the amount of water you use during three complete billing cycles. The City uses the months of Nov., Dec., and Jan. consumption.

- Three out of five home fire deaths result from fires in properties without working smoke alarms.
- More than 1/3 (38%) of home fire deaths result from fires in which no smoke alarms are present.
- The risk of dying in a home fire is cut in half in homes with working smoke alarms.
