

ORDINANCE NO. 2137

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 18, TRAFFIC, SECTION 18-151, SCHEDULE F, ONE-WAY STREETS, AT ALL TIMES, BY ADDING "EAST FAIR OAKS PLACE, ONE-WAY GOING EAST BETWEEN BROADWAY AND VANDERHOEVEN DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; REPEALING ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the regulation of traffic, motor vehicles and conveyances upon all public streets, roadway and right-of-ways within the City limits of the City of Alamo Heights (the "City") is essential and necessary to protect the traveling public and to preserve and protect the public safety of the City; and

WHEREAS, sections 311.001 and 542.202(a) (10) of the Texas Transportation Code provides that a municipality has exclusive control over and under the public highways, streets, and alleys of the municipality and the authority to designating a highway as a one-way street; and

WHEREAS, city staff made a presentation regarding high school student parking on residential streets to City Council and during the presentation parking solutions were offered to create additional parking on streets approved for student parking around the high school and an option to restrict traffic to one-way going east on East Fair Oaks Place between Broadway and Vanderhoeven Drive in order that parallel parking spaces along the north curb line are replaced with sixty degree angled head-in parking spaces to add a minimum of 30 additional parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief and City Manager worked closely with Alamo Heights Independent School District administration to formulate parking options in an effort to minimize student parking on residential streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: Findings. The recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Amendments to Chapter 18. Chapter 18 ("Traffic ") Section 18-151 shall be amended, which is entitled "Schedule F-One Way Streets" and which shall read as follows:

Sec. 18-151. - Schedule F-One Way Streets

Under the provisions of section 18-33, the following streets are designated as one-way streets for the times indicated:

At all times
Ausway Street, one-way going east to west.

*Corona Avenue, one-way going west between St. Luke's Lane and Jones
Maltsberger Road.*

*East Fair Oaks Place, one-way going east to west between Broadway and
Vanderhoeven Drive*

*St. Luke's Lane, one-way going north between Jones Maltsberger Road and
Corona Avenue*

SECTION 3. Conflicting Ordinances or Resolutions. All resolutions or ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance as adopted and amended herein, are hereby REPEALED to the extent of such conflict. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency between this ordinance and any other resolution, code or ordinance of the City, or parts thereof, the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its approval and passage in accordance with the Texas Local Government Code and the city charter.
