

ORDINANCE NO. 2267

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE PROPERTY TAX REVENUE INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 BUDGET AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Sections 102.005 (b) and 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government relating in part to "truth-in-taxation disclosure"), requires a separate vote of the City Council to ratify a property tax revenue increase, if any, reflected in a newly adopted budget and providing the necessary disclosure language in the ratification, when there is an increase to the property tax revenues in the proposed budget as compared to the previous year; and

WHEREAS, the City's 2026-27 Budget has an increase in property tax revenues as compared to the previous year; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the approval of the 2026-27 Budget, the City Council finds that it must ratify the increased revenue from property taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The increased revenue from property taxes in the Fiscal Year 2026-27 City Budget is hereby ratified, with the following declaration:

THIS BUDGET WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY \$423,638.00 AS REFLECTED IN THE 2026-2027 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET ADOPTED ON AUGUST 24, 2026, AND IS HEREBY RATIFIED.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately after passage.

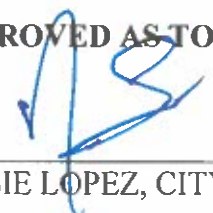
