1. From the Beginning Date through the Ending Date, the City and its authorized agents and representatives may enter the Subject Property to perform work consistently with the Purpose of Access. In so doing, the City may employ such equipment and independent contractors as it deems necessary or convenient to accomplish the Purpose of Access. The City's rights and obligations under this Agreement may be assigned to and used by its contractors, and the City's contractors or City forces may rely on and act under the rights granted by this instrument.
2. The City will attempt to minimize interference with the Owner's activities on the Subject Property. The Owner will accommodate the construction efforts by granting access and moving the Owner's property when necessary.
3. The City will perform all work at its own expense and will comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in the course of performing the work.
4. This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which is an original, whether or not all parties sign the same document. Regardless of their number, the counterparts constitute only one agreement. In making proof of the agreement, one need not produce or account for more counterparts than necessary to show execution by or on behalf of all parties.
5. In the event that the City's actions under this agreement cause damage to Owner's property, the City will repair the property to a form substantially similar to that of the property prior to this

agreement. This section does not relieve the Owner of the responsibility to accommodate the construction efforts by granting access and moving the Owner's property when necessary. This section does not hold the City of Alamo Heights liable for any preexisting failing or damaged private infrastructure or improvements on the property that may need to be repaired or modified outside the intended work scope or City assets.

6. All obligations of the City under this instrument are funded through the City of Alamo Heights and are subject to the discretion of City Council whether to appropriate funding for any given year of a term. If the City Council fails to appropriate money for this agreement in the City of Alamo Heights Budget, the City may terminate this agreement and have no further liability.

7. Owner acknowledges that this instrument is public information within the meaning of Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code and accordingly may be disclosed to the public.
